Do you **follow** the fashion in choosing clothes?

Well, I can say that I'm a real **fashionista**. I never stop **keeping up with** the **latest fashions** and I always try to wear **stylish** clothes. Many of my friends believe that I've got a good **sense of style** and I can realize what **looks good on** me and **goes with** my skin. However, I try not to get a **fashion victim**. I never wear something that is **trendy** but makes me look **odd**.

Fashionista: (n) someone who is very interested in fashion and who likes the very newest styles (informal)

Keep up with (someone or something): (phrasal verb) to go at the same speed as a person or thing, to maintain the same rate of progress

Example: Sometimes I can't keep up with the rest of the class.

Keep up with fashion: to make sure that you know about the most recent fashions

Latest: (adj) the most recent and the newest **Synonym:** up-to-date, fashionable

Example: His latest film is one of the funniest he's ever made.

Example: She always likes to have the very latest mobile phones.

fashion: (n) (Uncountable) The business and study of making and selling clothes, shoes, etc in new and changing styles

Example: This is a magazine about fashion and beauty.

(Countable) a style of clothes, hair etc that is popular at a particular time

Example: Lucy likes to keep up with the latest fashions.

Stylish: (adj) **Fashionable** and well-designed in an attractive way

Example: The furniture looked very stylish and modern.

sense of style: awareness of what is tasteful or fashionable

look good on somebody: When you think a person's haircut, makeup, or clothes match that person well, and make that person look good, you can say it.

Example: That dress looks so good on you.

Go with (somebody or something): to look good with something else

Example: Do you think that blue wallpaper will go with the carpet?

Fashion victim: (n) someone who always wears what is fashionable, even if it makes them look bad

Trendy: (adj) fashionable, **in fashion**, stylish

Odd: (adj) different from what is normal or expected **Synonym:** unusual, strange
